

VERMONT NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO THE BOARD CHAIR Effective November 13, 2018

To facilitate the continuous administration of the Vermont Natural Resources Board, as well as its participation in enforcement actions, permit appeals, Public Utility Commission matters, and legislative hearings without possible delays caused by waiting for Board meetings to occur, the Board delegates authority to its Chair over the following:

- 1. Day-to-day administration of the Board, including budget oversight.
- 2. Personnel matters including hiring.
- 3. Enforcement.
- 4. Participation in appeals and other litigation, subject to Board policy direction on basic positions.
- 5. Coordinating policy issues with the Governor's office, other agencies and persons.
- 6. Appearing in the Legislature on behalf of the Board, subject to appropriate Board policy direction on basic positions.
- 7. Other authority and duties as appropriate, or where it is not practical for the Board to act, or where action is necessary prior to convening a Board meeting.

This delegation of authority shall remain in effect until repealed or altered by the Board.
