- 1. The original of any document issued by a District Commission shall be signed by the Chair, or by the District Coordinator in cases where the Commission pursuant to Act 250 Rules delegates to the Coordinator the authority to sign or issue permits, and maintained in the files of the Commission.
- 2. Electronic and hard copies of documents can be issued by the Commission without the signature of the Chair, using the /s/ signature convention, as long as the Chair has authorized the document to be issued.
- 3. The District Office Support Staff shall send a copy of any document to be recorded in the land records to the municipality for recording.
